



Special-Needs Housing Search

Find housing for special-needs groups such as veterans, frail and elderly, emancipated youth, hearing and sight impaired clients, homeless, mentally ill, frequent users of the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services and Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health, persons with developmental disabilities, and more – through the Los Angeles County Housing Resource Center.

A Secure and Confidential Service for Agency Workers

- Authorized agencies can search for housing that meets client needs without sacrificing privacy rights.
- For access, agency workers must be approved and undergo confidentiality training.
- Listings include complete contact information to help caseworkers establish relationships with landlords.

A Wide Range of Housing Options

- Every property provider who registers to list is offered the opportunity to promote properties to special-needs populations.
- Listings are only known as available to those populations by authorized users with very specific permissions.
- By providing landlords an anonymous free way to connect with special-needs tenants, this service increases scattered-site housing for clients and facilitates relationship building between landlords and caseworkers.
- Use the Search Notification feature to sign up for email alerts about new listings.
